# Slippery Ethical Dilemmas That Can Place You at Risk

## Description

Dr. Chase and Dr. Lawrence will explore the ethical dilemmas involving such issues as self-disclosure, sexuality, gifts, dual relationships and third party referrals. In lecture and small group discussions, participants will examine how to respond to a range of challenging clinical situations, including dealing with sexual attraction. Special attention will be paid to a counselor's unresolved grief, co-dependency and compassion fatigue with respect to maintaining healthy boundaries.

## Edwin Chase, D. Min

Dr. Chase is a Pastoral Counselor who serves as Senior Chaplain and as Director of the Family Institute at the Methodist Home for Children and Youth. His B.A. Degree is from Emory University. He received his M.Div. at Yale University and his D.Min. degree at Columbia Theological Seminary. He is a Fellow of the American Association of Pastoral Counselors. Dr. Chase has taught in national seminars and has numerous articles published in magazines and professional journals.

## Jeffery D. Lawrence, D. Min.

Dr. Lawrence graduated from Morehouse College in Atlanta, and received his M.Div. in Christian Education/Church Administration and his D. Min. in 2004 from the ITC-Morehouse School of Religion in Atlanta. In 1988 he received his MSW from UGA. He is Licensed and Ordained in the Christian Ministry and became a Licensed Social Worker in 1991. Dr. Lawrence is a member of the National Association of Social Workers and Georgia Association of Homes and Services for Children. He is a Certified Trainer for the University of Oklahoma Advanced Training Course for Residential Child Care Workers and a trainer for the Foundations for Helping Professions Course. Dr. Lawrence has been employed at the Methodist Home for Children and Youth for 21 years and serves as Vice-President for Programs and Services/Chief Operating Officer.

## Directions:

### From Atlanta:

- I-75 South to the Arkwright Rd, Exit #169
- Turn right onto Arkwright Rd., then make an immediate left turn onto Riverside Drive.
- After 2.4 miles, at the traffic light turn right traveling uphill onto Pierce Ave.
- After you pass through the first traffic light (Ingleside Avenue), begin looking to the right for the red brick entrance sign to the Methodist Home. (You can't miss it.)
- Proceed straight ahead to the Rumford Center,.

### From Savannah:

- From I-16 West proceed to I-75 North and take Exit 167, Pierce Ave.
- The exit ramp will circle to the right placing you on Pierce Avenue. Proceed through the traffic light (which is immediate) at the intersection of Riverside Drive.
- After you pass through the next traffic light (Ingleside Avenue), begin looking to the right for the red brick entrance sign to the Methodist Home. (You can't miss it.)
- Proceed straight ahead to the Rumford Center.

### From Athens:

- South on Hwy 441-S to Eatonton. Follow Hwy 129 to Gray.
- Turn right at traffic light onto Hwy 22.
- Follow Hwy 22 into Macon to I-75 North to Pierce Ave., Exit 167.
- The exit ramp will circle to the right placing you on Pierce Avenue. Proceed through the traffic light (which is immediate) at the intersection of Riverside Drive.
- After you pass through the next traffic light (Ingleside Avenue), begin looking to the right for the red brick entrance sign to the Methodist Home.

Guests park in the lot in front of the Rumford Center (a large two story red brick building with glass front.) Overflow parking is behind the building to the right.
