The Methodist Home for Children and Youth in Macon has been approved as a qualified organization to benefit from a NEW Georgia State Tax Credit in support of older Foster Kids!

The GA Fostering Success Act (GA Code 48-7-29.24) has \$20 million available for 20 qualified organizations.

Credit Opportunities include:

- Single individual or a head of household Up to \$2,500
- Married couple filing a joint return Up to \$5,000
- LLC, S Corporation or Partnership Up to \$5,000
- Corporations / Others Up to 10 percent of tax liability
